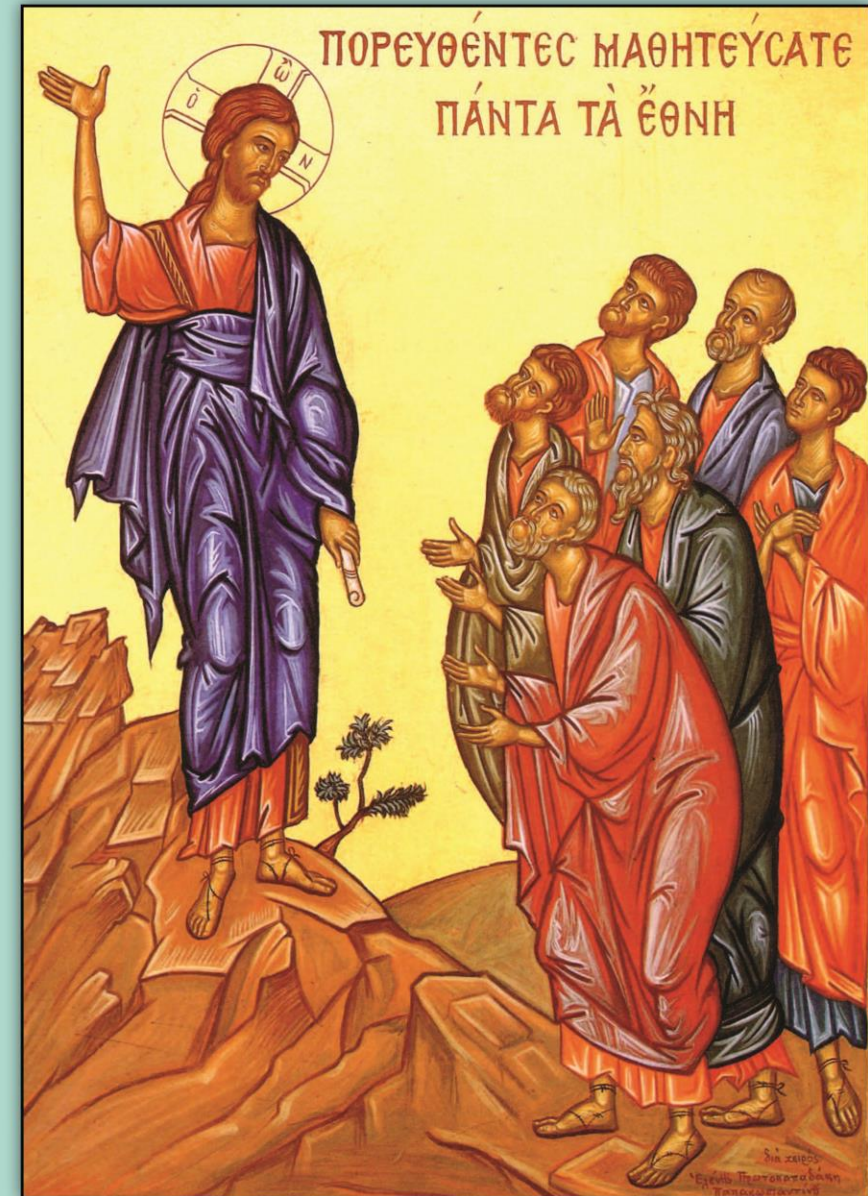
*Prove Your Faith by Your Trust*
