

"For one defect of condemnation, a person can become a drunkard, a fornicator, and even a robber. That's how scary it is to condemn! When we condemn someone, we crucify the Lord a second time and distance the Holy Spirit from ourselves, when we speak to a person - the same thing. Here, beloved, how terrible it is to judge and have a bad opinion about a person.

The peace of the soul is one of the most important indicators by which we determine whether we are spiritual or carnal. If the peace in our soul is not disturbed under any circumstances, even under the strongest experiences, then we are with God. No matter how upset we are, no matter what evil is done to us, no matter what loss we suffer, we should always be peaceful and calm in spirit.

And this is possible only if we sincerely love God and our neighbors, if we have deep faith and devotion to the Providence of God, if we tolerate all evil, all sorrows and illnesses with complacency.

We emphasize more carefully how God punishes us with calamities, and we do not want to notice how He has mercy on us much more with His long-suffering and bounties. Often, the same thing that we tend to consider as a disaster and punishment of God, is a true beneficence of God, which prevents, according to God's Providence, not one disaster, but sometimes a whole series of other disasters and troubles.
